1. Editing video

What is video editing, what is the editor's job? Hard ware and software requirement, Input and output (I/O) devices, Digital Data, Video input, Computer & editing software, Video output, Memory cards, USB Cable, Digital advantage and disadvantage

2. The Tools of editing

Non-linear editing software: Its grade, capability and cost, image editing, audio editing and visual effects software, Adobe Premiere

Hardware configuring the workstation, fast processor cores, system memory, hyper-fast data storage devices, digital signal processing, GPU adapters

External video editing controls, USB units; Minimum system requirement

3. Digital Video work flow

Major stages: a) Getting a digital video data stream into the editing software b) The digital video editing c) Exporting of your project, using popular digital video file formats.

Project design: Capture: direct from camera, quick scan, file import and stop motion, or screen capture data import. Connection between the source hardware and the workstation; Editing, effects, audio, compositing, transitions, motion, and construction work process.

Time line editing: meaning and definition, nonlinear timeline editing, Components: Time-code marker and location, Tracks, media, play head.

4. Editing Principles

Organizing and viewing the rushes, Devising a paper edit, The structure on the timeline, Rough cut, Addition of appropriate transitions

Master shot for an over view, Changing size of the shots stepwise, Cutaways, Edit on action, editing moving shot with static shot

Common Transitions: The Cut, fade, Cross Dissolve, Wipe. Meaning of transitions.

Editing audio in video, Understanding Pace

5. Enhancing the video

Titles and Credits, its need, historical development of titles, Different choices to match the mood of the movie, Types of titles: simple fade in and out, Pop-up, Rolls, Crawls, animated, Font size, un-obstructive, Superimposition, Graphics, animation
